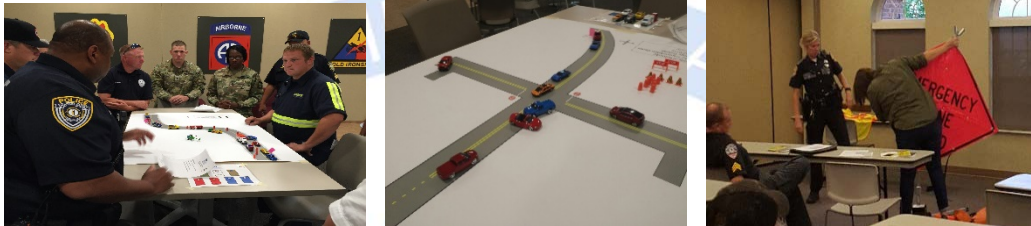

Become a Traffic Incident Management (TIM) Trainer!

Description: This national training program is building a team of well-trained responders who can work together as a team in a coordinated manner from the moment the first emergency call is made to final scene clearance. As a TIM trainer you will be able to help the TIM initiative by training first responder's three objectives: Responder Safety, Safe, Quick Clearance, and Prompt, Reliable Interoperable Communication.

The Train-the-Trainer (TtT) course is intended to provide participants (i.e., trainers) the knowledge and materials necessary for them to conduct TIM training for TIM responders in their area or state.

The target audience for this course is **experienced trainers** from all TIM disciplines, including: Law Enforcement, Fire/Rescue, Emergency Medical Service, Towing and Recovery, Emergency Management, Communications, and Highway/Transportation. *Each TtT participant is expected to have both prior instructional and TIM experience.* **If you are already a TIM trainer, we will be having a refresher course in the next upcoming weeks, you do not need to register for this training.**
