JOB SUMMARY:

Position is classified as Non-Hazardous and involves but is not limited to: collecting, processing, and preserving evidence at crime and traffic scenes. Occasionally, this position may require hazardous duty performance, such as special duty assignments, natural disasters, etc.

QUALIFICATIONS AT TIME OF APPLICATION:

This position requires a Bachelors Degree in Criminal Justice or other job related field and a minimum of 10 years work experience as a law enforcement officer or as an evidence collection technician, or an equivalent combination of education and experience may be acceptable. Must be POPS certified by the State of Kentucky and have satisfactorily completed a Police Academy as a police officer and possess a valid driver's license.
