CURRENT KENTUCKY SWORN OFFICER

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Be a US Citizen
- Valid driver's license
- Three (3) years consecutive law enforcement paid experience in a full-time capacity
- Must be POPS (Peace Officer Professional Standards) certified through the Department of Criminal Justice Training, without having to attend the Academy
- Must also meet additional demands/criteria as required by KLEC and City of Owensboro

CURRENT SWORN OFFICER FROM OUTSIDE KENTUCKY

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Be a US Citizen
 - Valid driver's license
 - Three (3) years consecutive law enforcement paid experience in a full-time capacity
 - Must be approved through the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council (KLEC) , call 1-859-622-6218 or visit www.docjt.ky and click on KLEC icon in left hand corner
- Items KLEC requires to review training:
1. a transcript of the topics and hours of the basic course taken including hours per class and total number of hours completed
 2. a copy of your graduation certificate
 3. proof that you have worked at least one year as a full time peace officer in the same state as the LEN training academy from which you graduated
- Must also meet additional demands/criteria as required by KLEC and City of Owensboro

BENEFITS: These include 26 vacation & 12 sick days yearly, uniform/equipment furnished with \$650 annual allowance, paid funeral & military leave. Also available are options for health, dental, vision, and life insurance. Pay rate is subject to years of experience. CERS Hazardous Duty Retirement through the Kentucky Retirement System.

CURRENT STATE INCENTIVE PAY: After completion of required training, police officers may be subject to approximately \$333/month in state incentive pay, subject to change.

CURRENT REGULAR WORK HOURS: 8 hour days (40 hours/week). Shift assignments may vary (1st, 2nd, 3rd shifts).
